About Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP):

The course structure of FYUGP is built on the Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS). Though, the FYUGP is basically a CBCS, it is radically different from the courses running under CBCS. Namely, it does not differentiate between so-called Honours and Pass courses existing under CBCS.

Duration:

While under CBCS, one has a 3-year degree programme, under the NEP's FYUGP, it is a 4-year degree programme.

Exits & Entries:

Under CBCS, one needs to complete the full 3-year programme in order to get adegree. There is no provision for dropping out of the programme in the middle. While in the FYUGP, one has choice to exit from the programme thrice – after one year, after two years and after three years. If one exits the programme after one year, one gets a certificate. If one exits after two years, one gets a diploma. If one exits after three years, one gets a Bachelor's Degree and finally if a student completes the whole 4-year, one gets a Bachelor's Degree with Honours.

IMPORTANT: If you exit in the middle, the doors are still open for you to enter into the programme again and you can start the journey from where you left. No such provisions exist in the CBCS.

Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP):

Progression:

The progression during the whole course structure is shown in the figure below. There are three pathways to the doctoral course or PhD course.



After 3-Year Bachelor Degree:


After a 3-Year Bachelor Degree, a student can take admission in the 2- Year Masters Course and advance to doctoral program. This pathway is similar to what we have now.

After 4-Year Bachelor Degree with Honours:

Students completing a 4-Year Bachelor Degree with Honours will take admission into the second year of Master's program and can advance to the doctoral program.

After 4-Year Bachelor Degree with Honours and Research:

This pathway is for only exceptional students who can directly advance to a doctoral program right after graduation. So, there shall be a necessary qualifier process which will ensure that only high-quality motivated students can take this pathway. All other students must go through the second year Master's program in order to be able to take admission in a doctoral program.





Credit Framework:

Each semester of a 4-Year Bachelor Degree (FYUGP) course will have a maximum of 22 credits with a total of 132 credits for 3-Year Degree Course and 176 credits for a 4-Year Degree Course. Apparently, the Masters Course will have 44 credits in a year with a total of 88 credits in two years. The baseline for total credits is 120 for a 3-Year course and 160 for a 4-Year course. So, a student can choose to have a total credit between 120 and 132 by the end of a 3-Year Bachelor Degree course.

The basic division of credits for a 3-Year Bachelor Degree course is shown in figure alongside. The basic division for a 4-Year course is shown in Fig.fig: Division-of-credits-1 and fig: Division-of-credits-1-1. In the 4th year, there are however two options — (a) Degree with Honours and (b) Degree with Honours and Research. Overall, a 3-Year Degree course consists of two sections — a Core Section and a Common Section. While the Core Section consists of Major and Minor papers, the Common Section is divided into 5 sub-groups.

Internship:

All student is to carry out an internship with a credit allocation of 4.



As shown in the figures, the base credit score for a 3-Year course is 120 and a student needs to have at least 50% of 120 i.e. 60 credits in a subject to qualify for a major in that subject. In the same way a minor course will have 12 credits and a student can have two minors with a total of 24 credits. Apart from the Major subject, if a student can obtain 48 credits in a particular subject, the student will get a double major.

Course Structure, FYUGP (3-Year Degree):

The detailed course structure for a 3-Year Bachelor Degree is represented in the figure below. This structure depicts a general scenario where a student will choose one major course and two minor courses. It is to be noted that in order for a re-entry into the 3-Year course in Semester III or V for students who have opted for leaving the course after the 1st and 2nd year respectively, additional vocational course of 4-credit has to be done by the student on exit.








Fig. Course Structure for a 3-year Bachelor Degree.

The numbers indicate credits in the paper. The Voc-1 and Voc-2 papers are vocational courses that a student would have to take in the case of exiting in the 1st or 2nd year. These courses are NOT compulsory in general, but a student will need them for re-entry into the programme.

Requirements for admission:

- Student Seeking admission to college shall have to apply in prescribe form available with the prospectus.
- ii. Major and Minor will be offered at the time of admission.
- iii. Students need to submit the following photo copies of documents: -
- a) Marksheet and pass certificate of the last examination (2 copies)
- b) HSLC Certificate, Marksheet, Admit card (for age verification), Each (2 copies).
- c) Character certificate from the head of the institution last attended.
- d) Cast Certificate/ Gap period certificate/ Migration certificate/ Disability Certificate if required.



- e) Registration Certificate of AHSEC/GU (2 Copies)
- f) It is mandatory that a student under GU-FYUGP register for the ABC ID asnotified by the regulatory agencies at the time of GU registration.
- g) In respect of reservation under games and sports quota and extra curricular activities, only state and national certificates from competent authority will be considering.
- Two copies of latest passport size colour photos with white background.
- i) Photo copy of tree plantation (for fee waiver candidate)
- j) Bank passbook xerox copy.

- Original copies of certificates and mark sheets will be produced at the time of submission of online receipt.

College Examination:

- I. In the present semester system (FYUGP) 40% of total marks come from Internal Examination and rest 60 % from end semester evaluation. II. The Students must appear the sessional examination conducted by the college. No application seeking exemption from appearing the sessional examination will be entertained. However, if any student fails to appear in the sessional examination, due to some genuine, he/she will duly apply to the head of the dept. concerned and must appear in the sessional exam within 10 days from the completion of scheduled dates of each sessional exam.
- III. Nobody will be allowed to appear in the final examination without appearing the sessional examination conducted by the college.

- Application form for admission must be submitted to the office. The submitted form must be completed in all respects. Incomplete forms are liable to be rejected.

+ ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

- Right of admission is reserved by the college authority.
- (ii) Students are admitted strictly on merit basis.
- (iii) Reservation of seats for SC/ST/MOBC/EWS will be in accordance with the rules existing at the time of admission.
- (iv) Preference will be given to the students having high standard qualities of extra curricular activities and outstanding sportsmanship. The quota is limited.
- (v) Seats remained vacant after fulfilling rules(ii), (iii) and (iv) above will be filled by general category candidates.

* MANAGEMENT :

The college is managed by the Governing Body constituted by the Govt, of Assam.

+ FEES STRUCTURE:

Admission and other fees structure will be as per prescribed by Govt. of Assam. It will be intimated in College website and College notice board before the commencement of admission process.



+ ATTENDANCE:

As per University rules 75% attendance in the classes is compulsory.

OTHER AMENITIES:

I) IDENTITY CARD:

Every student on admission will be issued with an Identity Card which is to be kept with him/her during the college hours. At the end of each academic session, the old Identity Card is to be surrendered for renewal.

II) LIBRARY CARD:

A student is provided with a Library Card with the facility to borrow two books at a time. A Major student can borrow 4 (four) books at a time which are to be returned within a maximum of 15 days.

In addition there is a reading room to go through news papers and periodicals. A student must return the Library Card at the end of each session.

III) SPORTS:

The college is well equipped with all modern indoor and outdoor games & sports. Enough facilities are given to sports deptt. of the college to participate in various tournaments held outside college campus time to time.

IV) TUTORIAL CLASSES:

In addition to the regular routine classes, the authority arranges for tutorial classes in certain subjects. It is compulsory for the students to attend the same.

V) STUDENTS UNION:



Katahguri College Students Union (KCSU) is the general body of students of the College and all the students are members of the Union. The students seeking to contest the Union Election must attend minimum of 75% classes held till the date of notification of the Election.

VI) POOR FUND:

The Katahguri College Students Union has Poor Fund facility. Generally, the financially weak students are provided with some financial assistance from this Fund at the time of form-fill-up for University Examinations.

VII) COLLEGE MAGAZINE & WALL MAGAZINE :

Katahguri College Students' Union pubilshes a yearly magazine which provides the students and also the staff of the college an opportunity to display their creative talents. In addition to this, there is a general Wall Magazine and Departmental Wall Magazines which also serve the same purpose.

VI) SCHOLARSHIPS:

- Meritorious Students belonging to religious minority category who attains atleast 50% marks in the last final examination will be awarded Post Matric Scholarship as prescribed by the Govt. of Assam.
- Post-Matric Scholarship for ST/SC/OBC/MOBC and Minority Girls' students will be awarded as prescribed by the Govt. of Assam.



VII) SUPPORT SERVICES IN THE COLLEGE:

For a better teaching-learning experience in the college the following support service are offered as —

- The students securing highest marks in Council and University examinations are rewarded.
- 2. The most regular and punctual students are rewarded.
- The teachers of the departments who shows good results are encourged by offering certificates of proficiency.
- Departmental seminars, workshops are organised for the benefit of the students.
- Quiz compitition, debate, extempore speech etc. are held at regular intervals for updating the knowledge of the students.

VIII) PARKING SHED:

There are separate parking sheds available in the college campus for the students and the college staff for parking their bicycles, two-wheelers and cars.

IX) College Canteen:

Katahguri College has a canteen which serves nutritious and hygenic food to the students and staffs.



GENERAL RULES FOR MAINTENANCE OF DISCIPLINE AND ACADEMIC ATMOSPHERE AMONG STUDENTS:

- (i) The students will have to maintain high standard of discipline, good conduct and abide by the rules and regulations of the college prescribed by the college authority. Guardians are also presumed to have agreed to these rules when their wards join the college.
- (ii) Violation of college rules, discourtesy to teaching and non-teaching staff in any form, adoption of unfair means in the examination may lead to suspension, compulsory transfer or expulsion from the college.
